

# Explore BunGeo

Adventurers will love the Bunbury Geographe region, a place to experience encounters with wild dolphins, canoe and kayak along stunning waterways and hike through ancient Australian bushland. It's also home to arguably Australia's best mountain bike trails.

Note: If you are intending to drink make sure you have a designated driver and do not attempt any of the mountain biking or water-based activities.

## DAY ONE: PERTH TO BUNGEO

Drive 90 minutes south of Perth to the town of Harvey. Visit the award-winning Harvey River Estate and scale the Big Orange for panoramic views of the countryside. In the main street, check out GeoVino's range of local wines and produce. Then drive to Wokalup for a pub lunch at Brugan Brewery. A minute down the road is Harvey Cheese, makers of the creamiest cheeses and ice cream, and it has a new distillery making spirits from whey. Then it's on to Cycletrek at Kambaram (booking essential) to learn about mountain bike maintenance or explore their 10km of mountain bike trails. Next stop is Glen Mervyn Dam for an afternoon of relaxing by the water or swimming, fishing or kayaking. Explore a section of the Bibbulmun Track which runs close to the dam. Head to your accommodation for a rest before dinner.

## DAY TWO: CYCLE MANIA

Collie is a mountain bike mecca. Bring your own bike or hire one from Crank 'n' Cycle in Collie. Grab a coffee at The Wagon and maybe some morning tea from Forrest French Hot Bread across the road. Download the Wambenger Trails app and spend the morning exploring the Wagyl Biddi trails which offer experiences for a range of abilities. Head to Harris River Estate for a long lunch along with wine and gin tastings. You can spend the afternoon exploring the walk trails in Wellington National Park, make sure you visit the Dam Wall mural. If you are still keen to cycle, you could visit

the Arklow mountain bike trails many of which are quite challenging. (Remember not to drink and cycle.) Head back to your accommodation or if you are camping, Potter's Gorge has good facilities and stunning views of the stars on clear nights.

## DAY THREE: COASTAL ADVENTURES

Start today with a visit to the Dardanup Bakery for a coffee and sweet or savoury treat. Their pies are filling, and the doughnuts are fabulous. Book an early morning boat trip with the Dolphin Swim or Eco Cruise through the Dolphin Discovery Centre. The cruise leaves around 8am and booking is essential, but the experience is truly bucket list worthy. When you get back check out the interaction zone on the beach for more close dolphin encounters then explore the centre. Head home to Perth with a worthy detour to the Old Coast Road Brewery for some hearty pub food and local brews.


