

Explore BunGeo

There's a huge amount of rich, historic, and artistic culture to explore in the Bunbury Geographe region.

DAY ONE: PERTH TO BUNBURY

Drive south from Perth for two hours to Bunbury. Plan to arrive in the early afternoon and visit the Bunbury Museum and Heritage Centre to get an overview of the story of Bunbury. Explore the Waterfront Precinct which tells some of the stories of early Bunbury and has the beautiful Wardandi Boodja sculpture. There are plenty of restaurants for dinner along the Waterfront Precinct or on Victoria Street.

DAY TWO: BUNBURY ART SCENE

Wake up slowly and go for a leisurely breakfast at the Parisienne La Pause Miam or Benesse café. Either download a map or pick one up for free at the Visitor Centre and spend the morning exploring the Bunbury CBD Art Trail either on foot or hire an e-scooter. Stop in at Guardians of Happiness for a morning tea treat. Then explore the Bunbury Regional Art Gallery which has a great program of frequently changing exhibitions. Have lunch on Victoria Street either at The Rose Hotel, Nicola's Ristorante, Benesse or Kokoro, then spend the afternoon exploring Bunbury and discovering cool shops. Sightseers will love Marlston Hill Lookout which gives great perspective of the city and why it is called the 'city of three waters'. Check out the striking chequered lighthouse and Wardandi Memorial Park. The Back Beach is an excellent place to watch the sunset and Market Eating House is well worth a visit for dinner. End the evening with a nightcap at Lost Bills bar.

DAY THREE: COLLIE TO PERTH

Up early for a jam-packed day. First, a quick breakfast at The Happy Wife that comes with bonus water views. Drive to the Wellington Dam Lookout to see the work of Aboriginal Artist Jade Dolman and the spectacular

8000m² Reflections mural by Guido van Helton on the dam wall. On to Collie. Grab a coffee before exploring the Collie mural trail by downloading the Wambenger Trails App or book a tour with Forest Explorers. The Collie Art Gallery has a great program of exhibitions, there's an extensive historical collection at the Collie Coalfields Museum and the newly renovated replica coal mine at the Collie Visitor Centre is a must-visit. For lunch, drive to Harris River Estate which has wonderful views, delicious food, wine, and gin.

Drive back to Perth via the Harvey Region. Stop at Harvey Cheese for ice cream, cheese, and their award-winning gin. In town, GeoVino has wine, local produce, and gifts, and Harvey Bizee Hands showcases local produce and crafts. Walk around the Stirling Cottage Garden and visit the nearby Italian Internment Camp Memorial before heading back to Perth.
