

Explore BunGeo

Located just over two hours south of Perth, Bunbury is WA's largest regional city and is a destination packed with options for a quick weekend break as well as longer holidays. Surrounded by the waters of Geographe Bay, Koombana Bay and the Leschenault Inlet, the thriving city of Bunbury has a relaxed coastal vibe. Indulge in a buzzing food and bar scene, take serene walks along the beach and through beautiful bushland, and discover Bunbury's history, art and culture.

To make things easy for you we have created a suggested itinerary to help you explore the city.

DAY ONE: PERTH TO BUNBURY

Check into your accommodation, then take a stroll along the waterfront and up to Marlston Hill Lookout for a bird's eye view of the city. Wander to the Waterfront Precinct or along Victoria Street for drinks and dinner.

DAY TWO: DOLPHINS AND ART

Early breakfast and then head to the Dolphin Discovery Centre (DDC) and join the Dolphin Swim or Eco Cruise (booking is essential). Spend 90 minutes on the water learning about Koombana Bay's resident dolphins and if you are lucky, you can even swim with them. Back at the beach check out the Interaction zone then have a quick cuppa at the DDC Café, before exploring the Interpretation Centre.

Wander along the waterfront past the playground and to the giant metal sculpture Wardandi Boodja. Check out Taffy's for a sweet treat (or two) then find a place for lunch with a view. After lunch, spend some time shopping, visit the Bunbury Regional Art Gallery or Bunbury Museum and Heritage Centre or follow the City Centre Mural Trail. The Visitor Centre has maps to follow on foot, or hire an e-scooter as you discover the 35 hidden artworks across the city. La Pause Miam or Guardians of Happiness are great cafes for coffee and afternoon tea.

Finish your day strolling along the Back Beach. Check out the lighthouse, explore the ancient basalt rocks and rock pools or just watch the sun set over the ocean. For dinner, head to Victoria Street where there are plenty of options including Mojoes, Yours and Mine and Froth Craft Brewery. End the day with a nightcap at the cool bar Lost Bills.

DAY THREE: MANGROVES TO PERTH

Hire a bike from Melo Velo and cycle round to the Mangrove Boardwalk and down Richardson Street to Austral Parade for breakfast at the Happy Wife with amazing food and waterfront views.

After returning your bike to Melo Velo drive back to Perth. Take a little detour into Australind for lunch at the popular Treendale Farm Hotel.
