

Explore BunGeo

Capel is home to the last remaining Tuart Forest, stunning white sandy beaches, and charming country towns. Take some time to explore. You won't be sorry.

DAY ONE: PERTH TO CAPEL

Travel south from Perth for an hour and 20 minutes taking a break at the Crooked Carrot on the Forrest Highway, they have great food, coffee and produce and play areas for kids and dogs. Carry on another 43 minutes until you arrive in Capel. Head to Capel Vale winery for a tasting before heading to the coast and Peppermint Grove Beach. Book into your accommodation and take a walk along the beautiful beach. Make sure you check out the lookout for amazing views.

DAY TWO: EXPLORING THE TUART FOREST

Have a leisurely breakfast in Capel. There are plenty of choices including Capelberry Café and the Capel Bakehouse. If you have kids with you visit the skatepark. Then head to the Tuart Forest where you can take a scenic drive, explore the heritage village, visit Wannerup House, home to some of the early



settlers, and even have a go at the high ropes course at Forest Adventures. Head back to Capel for some lunch. In the afternoon you can go to the Capel Golf Club for a round of golf or head out to Ironstone Gully for a nature walk. While you are there you can visit Oakway Estate for wine tasting and great food.

DAY THREE: CAPEL TO PERTH

The fourth Sunday of the month is market day and heritage day in Boyanup. Have breakfast in Capel then head to Boyanup. Check out the farmer's market for fresh produce and Rustic French Living for beautiful furniture, gifts and morning tea. Explore the town's trails and the Rail Heritage Centre. If you have kids with you head to the Gravity ETC Centre to let them blow off some steam on the trampolines. Grab some fish and chips from the Happy Snapper to eat on the beach at Dalyellup before heading back to Perth.
