

# Explore BunGeo

The region is home to some very exciting wineries many of which focus on Spanish and Italian grape varieties. Tempranillo and Fiano particularly seem to thrive.

We recommend having an esky in the car to store your foodie goodies. Make sure you have a designated driver or book a tour.

## DAY ONE: GRAZING HARVEY REGION

Head south of Perth for an hour and 20 minutes before turning off the highway to visit Vineyard 28. Book one of their wine tours and explore a taste of Italy. You can choose a tour that includes lunch or head on to the Old Coast Road Brewery for lunch, they offer hearty pub food and have beer and spirit tastings. After lunch head into Harvey town and climb the big orange to get great panoramic views. Then pop into Harvey River Estate to try some of their wines. In the town centre explore GeoVino which has both wine and local produce. Gather some local goodies for a picnic dinner. Head to Wokalup and have a quick drink at Brugan Brewery and then on to Harvey Cheese for cheese and gin tastings and other local produce for your picnic. Drive to your accommodation, stay at one of the charming B&Bs in Harvey or in the Ferguson Valley.

## DAY TWO: EXPLORE THE FERGUSON VALLEY

Ferguson Valley is home to several excellent wineries, many providing the chance to try Spanish and Italian varieties that are not found in other WA wine regions. After a leisurely breakfast start the day exploring the area. Head to the Wellington National Park and check out the massive mural on the dam wall. The King Jarrah is worth visiting then head on to Gnomesville, home to thousands of gnomes from all over the world. For lunch drive along Ferguson Road, there are plenty of spots to choose from with booking essential. Hackersley and St Aidan have wonderful menus, Ferguson Falls offers gourmet pizzas with Bush Shack and Wild Bull

offering hearty pub food and great beer. After lunch there are still a couple of wineries to explore. Don't miss Green Door with some of the most spectacular views in the valley and excellent Spanish variety wines and of course Willow Bridge Estate. Evedon Lakeside Retreat offers dinner on Friday and Saturday nights.

## DAY THREE: DONNYBROOK AND BALINGUP

Start the day with a brew from Coffee Joy in Boyanup before heading on to Donnybrook, the apple capital of the region. Check out the Fruit Barn as you enter the town which has a great range of local fruit and veg. In autumn you can also arrange to pick your own apples. Head to Park Café in the town centre for morning tea. Then on to explore the region's wineries. You can make a day of exploring the cellar doors near Donnybrook: Thomson Brook, Barrecas, Coughlan Estate and Oakway Estate. If you choose this option have lunch at Coughlan Estate or head into Donnybrook and try out one of the cafes or bakeries. If you still have time, venture a bit further to Balingup and the multi award winning Small Water Estate then explore Balingup before heading back to Perth.
