

# Explore BunGeo

Located 90 minutes from Perth, the Harvey Region provides a brilliant location for a day trip, long weekend or longer holiday. Home to the Pinjarup and Wardandi people of Noongar Boodja, the region runs from the sparkling blue waters of the Geographe Bay to the hills of the Darling Scarp. Known for its farm fresh produce and home to major food brands Harvey Fresh and Harvey Beef, there is plenty to explore in the Harvey Region.

To make it easier for you we have created a suggested itinerary.

## DAY ONE: PERTH TO HARVEY REGION

Head south from Perth and check out Vineyard 28 for a little taste of Italy. Specialising in Italian varietals such as Arneis, Dolcetto, Nebbiolo and Fiano, Vineyard 28 offers a range of immersive tasting experiences. Book ahead to avoid disappointment. Head on to Old Coast Road Brewery for lunch. This family friendly venue has a cracking mini golf course featuring some of WA's natural icons as well as great food and locally made beer, cider and spirits. After lunch head into Harvey town centre and explore Harvey River Estate Winery, make sure you climb the Big Orange. Check out GeoVino for local produce and wine tasting and gather some produce for a picnic dinner. Check out the Italian Internment Camp Memorial and the beautiful Stirling Cottage Gardens. Harvey Bizee Hands on South Western Highway has lots of locally made crafts and food items. Finish the day with a picnic of your locally made goodies at the Harvey Dam or your accommodation.

## DAY TWO: NATURE LOVER'S PARADISE

Spend today soaking in the beautiful natural environment. Head to Benesse at Australind for breakfast overlooking the Leschenault Inlet. Take a walk or cycle in the Leschenault Conservation Park and then head up to Binningup Beach to take in the

beautiful waters of Geographe Bay. Soak up the sun, go for a swim or do a spot of fishing. Head back inland for lunch at Brugan Brewery at Wokalup. Try their locally made brews and don't miss out on their hearty paddock to plate menu. If you still have room stop in at Harvey Cheese, just one minute up the road. In addition to locally made cheeses and ice cream, make sure you check out their distillery featuring award-winning spirits made from whey from the cheese making process. Then head to the Wildflower Ridge Walk to work off your lunch. In spring the walk has some beautiful wildflowers but at any time of year the views over the Harvey Dam are spectacular. If you are still hungry you can get fish and chips for dinner in Harvey town.

## DAY THREE: TAKE A DIP

On your way home visit Logue Brook Dam for a dip, some fishing or a kayak, or if you don't want to get wet walk or cycle some of the trails. Heading back to Perth make sure you duck into the award-winning Skipworth Wine Company near Yarloop. Head back to Perth and grab a pie at the award-winning Pinjarra Bakery in Waroona.
